

BSZ GOES GOBAL INTERNATIONALISATION AT BSZ PFARRKIRCHEN



The proximity to the neighbouring countries of Austria and the Czech Republic and also the increasingly culturally diverse workforces in the training companies at home make it necessary to offer our students opportunities to gain work and life experience abroad in order to better meet the demands of the world of work and to awaken and strengthen a willingness to travel.

For this reason, our internationalisation strategy "BSZ Goes Global" - supported by the European Erasmusplus funding programme - offers our about 2,100 students the opportunity to spend several weeks abroad in the Czech Republic, Ireland and Italy, where they can either complete internships or acquire additional job-specific qualifications in the fields of agriculture, business administration and trade, crafts, child education and home economics, electrical engineering and technical drawing.

For those who are unable to take advantage of the opportunity to spend time abroad, we provide proof of job-related foreign language skills in English with the so-called KMK foreign language certificate.

Our teaching staff are open to the world and also take part in further training courses in other European countries or explore how other schools in other countries face very similar challenges in order to gain inspiration for their own work.

We have anchored the cultivation of school partnerships and the expansion of international contacts in our school's guiding principles. From this, we derive varied goals and fields of action for the "BSZ Goes Global" strategy and the Erasmusplus plan.
